b. Student Matters

PSLE 2021

Our P6 graduands have performed well in the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE) 2021, achieving an overall pass rate of 99%, with 71.3% of them qualifying for the Express stream. We congratulate all our 2021 P6 students on their good performance and wish them the best, as they embark on the next chapter in their respective secondary schools.

Staggered Recesses and Meal Breaks

We have implemented 6 recesses last year to ensure effective safe management measures and this will be continued this year. In addition to the daily recess periods, the school has incorporated a 15-minute meal break into your child's daily timetable to help your child sustain himself / herself throughout the school day. During the meal break, your child will be allowed to eat healthy finger food such as raisins, nuts, buns, fruits and sandwiches in class. We seek your support to pack suitable food items to be consumed in class by your child.

As before, CCAs will be conducted on Tuesday and/or Friday from 1.45 p.m. – 3.45 p.m.

Camp iNspire for P1 - P6

All Outdoor Adventure Learning (OAL) cohort camps were not conducted last year and will remain suspended till further notice. In alignment with the national posture, we will inform you if it is permitted for us to resume outdoor camps and programmes in 2022.

Communication

Communication is important for ensuring your child's success. Please share with your child's teacher any information regarding his/her needs that will help us support him/her in his/her learning. You can use the Student's Handbook to communicate your concerns with your child's teacher. In the event that you wish to meet our teachers, please do so by making an appointment with them.

c. Safety & Administration

Safe Management Measures (SMM)

Our school will continue to ensure that safe management measures are put in place to keep our students safe in tandem with the national posture. Do work with us to remind your child to practise good personal hygiene, exercise social responsibility and abide by SMMs, at all times. Our school will continue to practise the following:

- a. Daily temperature-taking and visual screening to be carried out for all students and staff. We seek your assistance to ensure that your child brings a working personal Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) and his / her TraceTogether Token to school daily.
- b. Cleaning high-touch surfaces frequently and disinfecting the premises daily.
- c. Wearing of masks by all students and staff.
- d. Frequent hand-washing by students throughout the school day and wiping down shared tables and equipment after use.
- e. Intermingling across classes and levels will be minimised.
- f. Staggering dismissal timings to reduce congestion.

To disperse movement of students and de-congest the waiting area at the gates and pick-up points, we strongly encourage parents/guardians who are fetching their child/ward to arrive at the designated time. Parents waiting to fetch their child should practise safe distancing at all times.

As part of social responsibility, we urged all parents to alert the school immediately if their children are unwell. Children who are unwell or have a positive ART or PCR result must not return to school. If your child is placed on Health Risk Warning (HRW), do inform your child's Form Teacher immediately. Photo evidence of your child's negative ART result, with your child's name and date of the ART test written on the ART kit, must be forwarded to the Form Teacher daily before your child return to school.

As COVID-19 vaccination is an important strategy in the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic, we strongly encourage parents to get their child vaccinated for their protection as soon as possible. We will make arrangements to help your child to catch up with his / her work if he / she missed lessons due to the vaccination.

Parents are requested to inform their child's Form Teacher about the dates of vaccination of their child. This is for the school to excuse their child from strenuous physical activities for 2 weeks after vaccination.

Road Safety

If you are driving, please reduce vehicle speed when within the school's premises, stay alert for pedestrians and cooperate with traffic marshals. Please let your child/ward alight only at the designated drop-off points within the school and do not disembark your child indiscriminately. For the safety of all our students, please do not park your car outside our school gates during dismissal time to wait for your child/ward. You are advised to wait for your child/ward at the carparks next to blocks 272 and 283. Please be reminded that no parking is allowed:

- a. 9 metres within a bus stop area;
- b. 6 metres within a junction;
- c. 50 metres of a pedestrian crossing.

LTA officers can take necessary enforcement actions against drivers who park at these areas.

School Safety and Security

Should you need to come into our school compound, we seek your co-operation to report to the security post for check-in via SafeEntry and temperature-taking. You are required to wear the visitor's pass at all times, when you are in our school compound. To avoid disrupting our students' learning, parents are to proceed only to the General Office and not the classrooms.

Attendance

Should your child/ward be unwell and need to rest at home, kindly inform the Form teacher, and support your child's/ward's absence with either a medical certificate from a doctor or a letter of excuse from you.

Bookshop Opening Hours

To minimize intermingling between the students and parents, please note that the opening hours of the bookshop for parents are restricted to 12p.m. to 1p.m. and 1.45 p.m. to 3.00 p.m.

Photo-Taking for School Smart Cards

A photo-taking session will be held for all P1 students on Tuesday, 25 Jan 2022 and P6 students on Wednesday, 26 Jan 2022 for their School Smart Cards. Students will need to be in their school uniform for the photo-taking session.
